IFC 2006 Imperatives

1. To unite IFC fraternities for the betterment of the Greek community
 - a. Implement a fraternity-wide community service project
 - b. Implement an effective judicial board to eliminate negative confrontations
 - c. Create and implement a program geared towards bridging the gap between large and small, housed and non-housed chapters
 - d. Attend at least one chapter meeting/event of each IFC fraternity annually to show support.

 - a. Provide the opportunity for the VP of Recruitment to attend the NIC's Recruitment Boot Camp
 - b. Develop and implement a recruitment seminar/workshop that is adaptable for all UCF fraternities

 - a. Inform and encourage all chapters to participate in UCF community service and philanthropic events
4. To provide leadership opportunities for all chapters
 - a. Inform and encourage all chapters to participate in UCF leadership development

Here are your IFC officers' main goals...

Fern – VP of Administration and Communication

- Hold all IFC delegates accountable to ensure effective communication between IFC and its chapters
- Better utilize the IFC Web site for accurate communication

Paul –VP of Public Relations

- Produce a innovative and timely Greek Life Booklet for the betterment of the Greek community - Release at least 1 positive article a week for the UCF Future's 'Greek Beat'
- Provide chapter's with media/public relations

Brett – VP of Scholarship

- Aim to improve the fraternity GPA higher than all-men's average - 2.8
- Increase the attendance of Greek Student Success to an average of 30 people per session – Have at least 1 member from each fraternity come to one meeting
- Implement a minimum GPA to join and stay a fraternity member

Marlar – VP of Finance

- Maintain an Open Book Policy for IFC accounts
- Maximize IFC's collaboration with Greek Council

Scott – VP of Recruitment

- Stress recruitment 365 days year
- Improve advertising effectiveness - Greek Life Booklet, UCF Future, Marquee, Banner in student union, Flyer from OSI, collaboration with housing, etc
- Create and implement a 'how to recruit' workshop for all chapters
- Mandate registration for all potential new members

Andrew – VP of New Member Education

- Host a new member education orientation
- Host a new member educator conference roundtable
- Host IFC/JIFC retreat
- Improve the appeal of JIFC by implementing new programs and speakers
- Eliminate hazing in IFC organizations

Chad – VP of Risk Management

- Mandate chapters to host at least 2 risk management events a semester
- Provide the Greek community with at least 1 guest speaker a semester
- Recruit and train Greek specific peer educators

Chops – Executive Vice President

- Form an IFC specific judicial board – 1 guy from every chapter
- Establish a positive relationship with the Office of Student Conduct
- Establish clear and consistent parameters for all violations
- Recruit worthwhile chair positions

Fox - President

- Consistent and accurate communication between executive board and chapters
- Hold the IFC executive officers and delegates accountable to their oaths
- Positively represent IFC to UCF community
- Advocate beliefs and ideals of IFC to the UCF faculty and staff
- Ensure delivery of all ideas through fruition
